If you want to see fish or sea animals, you should go to the aquarium. You will enjoy the wonderful world under water. You will find that there are so many kinds of living things under water. There are some fish living in the deep area of the sea. In some aquariums, you can see the shows of sea animals, such as dolphins and seals.

Most zoos and aquariums have something to make people happy. For example, there is an event (A) "the Night Zoo." The zoo is opened in the evening and at night for the event. Some animals (②) until the evening, get up and move at night. People can enjoy watching those animals moving at night. Many zoos and aquariums are trying to show the natural style of living things to people. So (B) to the zoo or the aquarium is a lot of fun.

Zoos and aquariums have another important purpose. That is to study about nature and preserve it. Some kinds of animals are decreasing in number. If nothing is done for them, they are going to disappear soon. In some zoos and aquariums, some scientists study their ways of life and try to protect them.
