What food do you want to eat for dinner today? Curry and rice? *Tempura? Ramen?* Such dishes are originally from foreign countries. Today we have many kinds of food from abroad. Most Japanese people like them and they are very popular now.

Curry and rice is one of the most popular dishes in Japan. It is loved by so many people.

Curry is originally from India, but it (England to Japan / one / years / came / than / from / hundred / more) ago. In the eighteenth century, many people from England went to India and (A) a lot of things back to England. Curry was one of them. Then curry became popular in England. In the nineteenth century, some Japanese went to England and ate curry for the first time. Many people say that curry was introduced to Japanese people as a new food from Europe, not from India.

Tempura is also a popular Japanese food, and (②) curry, it came to Japan from Europe. Some people say that tempura is originally from Portugal. As for ramen, people say different things. Some people say that ramen was made in Japan for the first time during the Meiji period. But many people believe that ramen was originally introduced by Chinese cooks from China.

On the other hand, some Japanese dishes are going out of Japan now to many places in the world. Many Japanese foods have less fat, so many people think that they are good for health. Today Japanese restaurants are very popular in the world.

Some Japanese foods are changed in other countries. For example, "California Roll," a new kind of *sushi* made in America first, is different from original *sushi*. In Japan, originally, when you make *norimaki*, you will put rice and ingredients on a sheet of *nori* and roll them. So *nori* is outside and rice is inside. But a California Roll is different. When you make a California Roll, you will put a sheet of *nori* and ingredients on rice and roll them. So, *nori* is inside and rice is outside.

Now is the time of globalization. A lot of people are going out of their countries and (B) in other countries. They will take their cultures to other countries and bring the cultures there to their own countries. Maybe food is the same. In the future, globalization of food will be more common all over the world.
